Fire Princess/Fire Queen Rules and Regulations

1. The Franklin Vol. Fire Dept. Fireman's Carnival Pageant is open to female residents of West Virginia who have lived within the state for at least one year. The pageant will follow the rules of the WV Fairs and Festivals Pageant.
2. The Fire Princess contestants must be 12 years of age by 1/1/2010, and not have reached her 16th birthday by 1/1/2011. The Queen contestants must be 16 years old by 1/1/2011, and not have reached her 22nd birthday by 1/1/2011.
3. The pageant will be held at the Pendleton County High School Auditorium at 7pm on Saturday, June 5, 2010. Rehearsal will be held at the same location on Friday June 4, 2010 at 7pm. Registration deadline is May 28, 2010.
4. Contestants must be present at rehearsal in order to participate in the pageant. NO EXCEPTIONS!
5. The contestants will be judged on a set point system. The contestants will model in theme wear and an evening gown of their choice. All princess and queen contestants will have an interview with the judges. Theme wear will be Fire Department themed, be creative, use your imagination. Using at least one of these colors: red, gold, black.
6. Semifinalists will be asked to answer a question selected by the pageant committee and judges.
7. The newly elected Fire Princess and Fire Queen shall appear at the Franklin Vol. Fire Dept. Fireman's Carnival each night, and at different events throughout the year that will be specified.
8. The Fire Princess/Fire Queen may not compete for or hold any other title unless granted permission by the Franklin Volunteer Fire Department.
9. The Fire Princess/Fire Queen may not organize any pageant or use her title as part of a pageant without prior approval of Franklin Vol. Fire Dept.
10. If the Fire Princess/Fire Queen is not available for an appearance, the first runner-up will take her place and so on. The Franklin Vol. Fire Dept. must be notified prior to the event if this situation occurs. NO EXCEPTIONS!
11. The decision by the judges and the fire department officials of the election of the Fire Princess/Fire Queen and her court shall be final and this court will reign until a new court is selected. The reign shall be for a period of one year.
12. The Fire Princess/Fire Queen must be of good moral character and conduct. If there are any questions to if it has been broken the Franklin Vol. Fire Dept. line officers will have the final decisions on the disciplinary action to take place on a one on one basis.
13. The contestants must be attending school.
14. Each contestant will receive one guest pass; this will allow one person/helper a free
